Manager's Report

Forestry Operation – Summer operations have been very tough due to weather.

Fire Guard Rehab – BCWS has awarded Chinook the contract. Work has commenced on the Southside. Due date for completion is September 30th, 2020.

Forest for Tomorrow – Chinook has received approval of its operational plan. 5 Tenure Packages went out August 24th with a due date of September 14th.

LiDAR - Still within the Chief Forester's Office.

AAC – The Chinook Community Forest Information Package was sent out July 29th to the local Ministry Office with zero response to date.

Fire Mitigation – The province has contracted Forsite to lead the Crown Land Wildfire Risk Reduction within the Lakes Timber Supply area. 3-Phase Strategy - Tactical Planning, Site Level Planning, and Operational Treatment. Tactical Planning is currently underway for the Southside within the highest fire risk polygons that fall within the WUI.

Office – BLNDC has opened its building to visitors with guidelines remaining in effect; Sign in sheet, Mask and Disinfect hands.

With the help of BLNDC, Chinook's Annual Open House was a great success with approximately 150 people attending.
