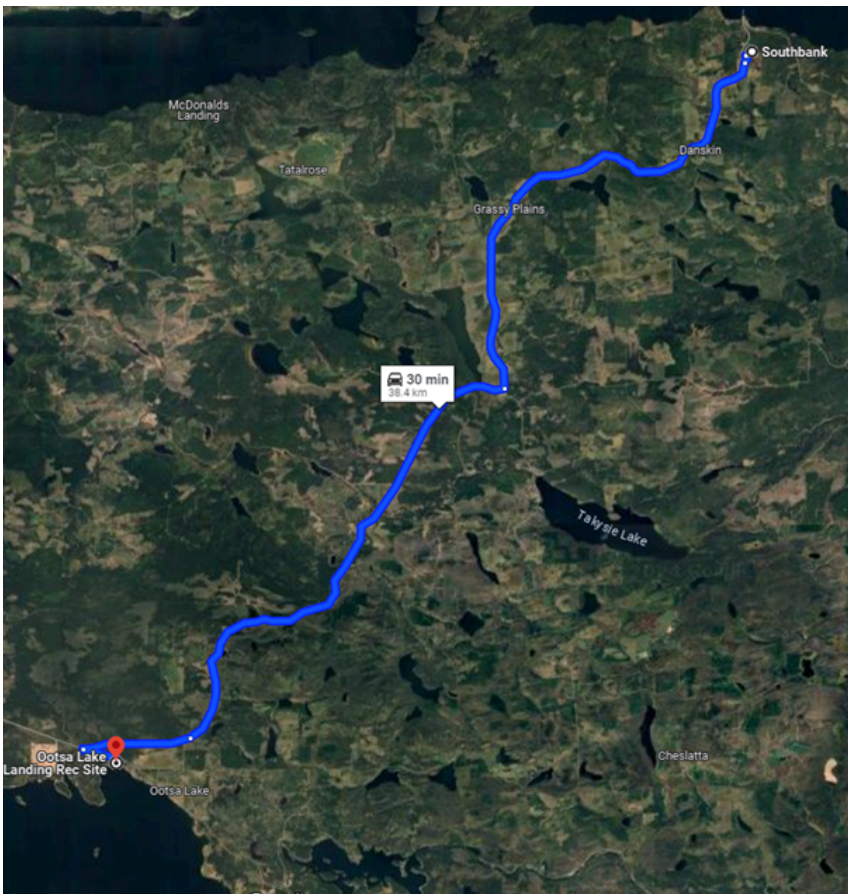

- Head south from Burns Lake on Hwy 35
- Catch the Francois Lake Ferry.
- Head straight up the hill after docking.
- Travel through Danskin and Grassy Plains.
- You will pass by the Grassy Plains Hall
- Turn **right** on to Keefe's Landing Rd. (Don't turn left to Takysie Lake if you end up at Takysie, turn around)
- Travel for 34+ kms on a paved road.
- Stay relatively straight until you reach the recreation site, you will turn left into the site.
- **There will be a signage with balloons along the way.**
